## Notice of Race

### 1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1, shall apply.
- 1.3 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

### 2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Phase 2 class.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached entry form and sending it, together with the required fee, to

- 2.3 Advanced entries will be accepted until the normal closing date of Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> January.
- 2.4 Late entries will be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion until 1000hrs, on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> January under the following condition. That they are lodged in person and are accompanied by an additional fee of \$10.00.
- 2.5 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrants and crew member's national authority and be a member of the NZ Phase 2 Association.

### 3.0 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee for this regatta will be \$70.00.

### 4.0 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration: Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> January, from 0830 hours to 0930 hours, at Sandspit Yacht Club.
- 4.2 Briefing: Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> January, commences at 0900 hours, at Sandspit Yacht Club.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1030 hours.
- 4.4 On Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 4 races back to back.
- 4.5 On Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> January 3 races back to back.
- 4.6 One extra race may be sailed each day provided the event becomes no more than one race ahead of schedule.
- 4.7 On Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> January, no warning signal will be made after 1355 hours
- 4.8 A total of 7 races are scheduled for the regatta.

### 5.0 MEASUREMENT

Measurement requirements are, that during the contest a boat or equipment may be inspected at any time to verify compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions.

## 6.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available upon registration.

## 7.0 VENUE

The races will be sailed on the water adjacent Sandspit Yacht Club at Algies Bay.

## 8.0 COURSES

The course(s) will be trapezoid, triangle - windward/leeward or windward/leeward.

## 9.0 SCORING

9.1 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.2 (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 6 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 10.0 PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded:

Masters Trophy – Helm over the age of 40 on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2010

Youth Cup – Helm and crew under the age of 19 on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2010

Most Improved Trophy (handicap)

National Phase 2 Championship Trophy.
